

## **AKEELA RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAMS**

## All Referring Professionals,

Thank you for considering Akeela's Residential Treatment Programs for your clients. To complete the referral process, please ensure that all required documents listed in the **Residential Treatment Application Checklist** are included with the application. Completed application packets can be submitted via fax or email to the appropriate Akeela Residential Treatment Program.

Due to the high volume of applications and limited availability of beds, we maintain a waitlist for applicants approved for admission. Applicants who meet the Priority Admission Criteria will be prioritized on the waitlist, as outlined in the State of Alaska Wait List Protocol. Please refer to page 4 of the Behavioral Health Registration Form for a complete list of priority criteria.

Please note, in accordance with Akeela's long-standing policy, individuals with pending criminal charges (pre-sentencing) are not eligible for admission to our programs.

It is important to inform applicants that submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance into Akeela's Residential Treatment Program. Once the completed packet is received, an interview with the Intake Coordinator of the designated program may be required. This interview can be conducted in person or over the phone. The final admission decision is based on a thorough review by the treatment team of the applicant's completed intake packet.

Please also inform the applicant that, after submitting a completed Residential Treatment Application, they will need to establish regular contact with the Residential Program Manager of the designated Akeela Residential Treatment Program. If the applicant does not have a phone or a reliable contact number, it is their responsibility to take the initiative and reach out to the Residential Program Manager on a regular basis.
